

The risk of Down syndrome is greater than the screening cut-off. Other outcomes of positive screens include normal pregnancy, over-estimated gestational age, and fetal demise. Genetic counseling regarding the risks and benefits of cell-free DNA (NIPT) and fetal diagnostic testing is suggested.
