INTERPRETIVE INFORMATION: High Density Lipoproteins

An HDL cholesterol less than 40 mg/dL is low and constitutes a coronary heart disease risk factor. An HDL cholesterol greater than 60 mg/dL is a negative risk factor for coronary heart disease.

CHD Risk Factors:

- +1 Age: Men, 45 years and older  
Women, 55 years and older or premature menopause without estrogen therapy
- +1 Family history of premature CHD
- +1 Current smoking
- +1 Hypertension
- +1 Diabetes mellitus
- +1 Low HDL Cholesterol: 39 mg/dL or less
- 1 High HDL Cholesterol: 60 mg/dL or greater
