> INTERPRETIVE INFORMATION: Calcium, Ionized, Serum Differences between the ionized calcium result and the ionized calcium normalized to pH 7.4 are due to the sample having a pH significantly different from pH 7.4. Sample pH may be artificially decreased due to delayed processing and may be increased when the sample is exposed to air. Due to these factors it is recommended that the ionized calcium normalized to pH 7.4 be interpreted with caution and only used when the clinician has knowledge of the patient's acid/base status. Accurate determination of in vivo pH is best determined by arterial blood gas testing.
