The positive anti-HAV is consistent with recent or remote Hepatitis A infection or antibody response to HAV vaccination.

False positive anti-HAV can occur.

* Hepatitis A Antibody, IgM Equivocal (Ref Interval: Negative)

The anti-HAV, IgM is borderline and is therefore inconclusive. Retesting at one week intervals may assist in determining the seroconversion status of the patient.

Hepatitis A Panel Interpretation See Note

> The positive anti-HAV is consistent with recent or remote Hepatitis A infection or antibody response to HAV vaccination.

The anti-HAV, IgM is repeatedly borderline and is therefore inconclusive. Retesting at one week intervals will help distinguish between a rising or falling antibody titer.
