A lupus anticoagulant is not detected in the hexagonal phase phospholipid neutralization assay.

Lupus anticoagulant antibodies are heterogeneous and laboratory tests used to identify them demonstrate variable sensitivity. No single test will identify all lupus anticoagulant antibodies. The International Society on Thrombosis and Haemostasis recommends using two or more tests, based on different assay principles, to screen for a lupus anticoagulant before the diagnosis is excluded (Thromb Haemost 1995;74:1185-90). Test results should be interpreted in the context of clinical presentation.
