INTERPRETIVE INFORMATION: Bartonella henselae Ab, IgG

Less than 1:64 Negative: No significant level of Bartonella henselae IgG antibody detected.
1:64 - 1:128 Equivocal: Questionable presence of Bartonella henselae IgG antibody detected. Repeat testing in 10-14 days may be helpful.
1:256 or greater Positive: Presence of IgG antibody to Bartonella henselae detected, suggestive of current or past infection.

A low positive suggests past exposure or infection, while high positive results may indicate recent or current infection, but are inconclusive for diagnosis. Seroconversion between acute and convalescent sera is considered strong evidence of recent infection. The best evidence for infection is significant change on two appropriately timed specimens where both tests are done in the same laboratory at the same time.
