Aspergillus Antibody by CF <1:8 (Ref Interval: <1:8)
INTERPRETIVE INFORMATION: Aspergillus Antibody by Complement Fixation (CF)
Cross-reactions with dimorphic fungi are not unusual within the genus Aspergillus. A negative test does not exclude infection, especially in immuno-compromised patients. Best use of test is with paired sera taken three weeks apart to detect a rise in titer against a single antigen.

Aspergillus spp. Abs, Precipitin None Detected (Ref Interval: None Detected)
INTERPRETIVE INFORMATION: Aspergillus spp. Antibodies by Immunodiffusion
In general, immunodiffusion measures IgG and a positive result may suggest past infection. The test is positive in about 90 percent of sera from patients with aspergilloma and 50-70 percent of patients with allergic bronchopulmonary aspergillosis. A negative test (none detected) does not exclude aspergillosis.
