Circulating Immune Complex, C1q Binding

6.0 ug Eq/mL H (Ref Interval: 0.0-3.9)

This patient's serum shows reactivity in the circulating immune complex (CIC) inhibitory assay performed in conjunction with the C1q binding test. Reactivity in the inhibitory assay indicates the presence of aggregates of human IgG other than CICs which may be due to: 1) autoantibodies to C1q or 2) heat-inactivated or otherwise compromised serum samples. The presence of concomitantly occurring CICs cannot be confirmed in this patient.

INTERPRETIVE INFORMATION: Circulating Immune Complex, C1q Binding

Less than or equal to 3.9 ug Eq/mL is considered negative for circulating complement binding immune complexes.

Circulating immune complexes may be found without any evident pathology and positive results do not necessarily implicate the immune complex in a disease process.
