INTERPRETIVE INFORMATION: Trypanosoma cruzi Ab, IgG

1.0 IV or less.....Negative - No significant level of Trypanosoma cruzi IgG antibody detected.
1.1 IV......Equivocal - Questionable presence of Trypanosoma cruzi IgG antibody detected. Repeat testing in 10-14 days may be helpful.

1.2 IV or greater...Positive - IgG antibodies to Trypanosoma cruzi detected, which may suggest current or past infection.

This assay should not be used for blood donor screening or associated re-entry protocols, or for screening Human Cell and Cellular Tissue-Based Products (HCT/Ps). According to the CDC, at least two different serologic tests should be used to make the laboratory diagnosis of chronic Chagas Disease, as no single serologic test is sufficiently sensitive and specific.
