Anti-D (RH1) was identified in this patient's serum. No additional red cell antibodies were apparent at this time.

Anti-D is a clinically significant antibody capable of causing hemolytic disease of the fetus and newborn (HDFN) and transfusion reactions.

Patient history will need to be evaluated to differentiate between passively acquired antibody and sensitization to the D antigen.

If red cell transfusion is required for mother or infant, donor units selected shall be negative for the D (RH1) antigen and appear compatible by antiglobulin crossmatch.
