A positive A. phagocytophilum Antibody, IgM result alone may not be sufficient to confirm disease. To determine presence of disease, test acute and convalescent specimens. For acute/convalescent comparison, submit a second specimen collected 10-14 days later, clearly labeled as "convalescent." Co-infection with Lyme Disease and/or Babesiosis should also be considered.

INTERPRETIVE INFORMATION: A. phagocytophilum (HGA) Antibody, IgM

Less than 1:16 - No significant level of IgM antibodies to A. phagocytophilum detected.

Greater than or equal to 1:16 - Suggestive of a current or recent infection with A. phagocytophilum.
