less than 1:320.....Negative - No significant level of Campylobacter jejuni IgG antibody detected.
1:320 or greater.....Positive - IgG antibody to Campylobacter jejuni detected, suggestive of current or past infection.

The best evidence for current infection is a significant change on two appropriately timed specimens, where both tests are done in the same laboratory at the same time.
