Presumptive negative for malaria antigens by rapid antigen detection. Infection due to malaria cannot be ruled out. Malaria antigen in the sample may be below the detection limit of the test. Confirmation results by thin and thick smear microscopy will be reported when completed.

Parasites Smear (Giemsa Stain), Blood

Because of the intermittent nature of parasitemia, examination of smears from multiple specimens may be necessary. If the diagnosis of malaria is to be rigorously pursued, examination of 3 specimens taken at 6-8 hour intervals on 3 successive days regardless of clinical symptoms is recommended.
