- <1:10 Negative - No significant level of LCM virus IgM antibody detected
- >=1:10 Positive - Presence of IgM antibody to the LCM virus detected, suggestive of current or past infection.

The best evidence for current infection is a significant change on two appropriately timed specimens, where both tests are done in the same laboratory at the same time.
