Osmotic Fragility	See Note Patient red blood cells show normal osmotic fragility. Peripheral blood smear reveals no spherocytes.	
	If the clinical suspicion for hereditary spherocytosis is high, further analysis of RBC band 3 protein reduction by flow cytometry (ARUP test code 2008460) is recommended.

	INTERPRETIVE INFORMATION: Osmotic Fragility	
	For patients with acute hemolysis, a normal red cell osmotic fragility test result cannot exclude an osmotic fragility abnormality since the osmotically labile cells may be hemolyzed and not present. Recommend testing during a state of prolonged homeostasis with stable hematocrit.
