While the full scope of the relationship of antibodies to protection is not clearly defined, elevated titers have been reported to be associated with reduced relapse risk and to asymptomatic carriage. This test was developed and its analytical performance characteristics have been determined by Quest Diagnostics. It has not been cleared or approved by FDA.
