TEST INFORMATION: NRAS Mutation Detection Pyrosequencing

This assay is designed to detect mutations in codons 12, 13, and 61 of the NRAS gene which may indicate responsiveness to therapy that targets the MAP kinase pathway in melanoma as well as lack of response to EGFR inhibitors in other tumors, including colorectal cancer. Interpretation of NRAS test results depends on the tissue tested.

MELANOMAS: A mutation in the NRAS gene may indicate whether a tumor is likely to respond to therapy that targets the MAP kinase pathway.

COLORECTAL: A mutation in the NRAS gene may indicate lack of response to EGFR inhibitors.

Methodology: DNA is isolated from microdissected tumor tissue and amplified for codons 12, 13 and 61 of the NRAS gene. Mutation status is determined by pyrosequencing.

Limitations: Mutations in other locations within the NRAS gene or in other genes will not be detected.

Limit of detection: 10 percent mutant alleles.
