Coccidioides Antibody IgG ELISA, CSF8.7 IV H(Ref Interval: <=0.2)

Positive EIA results should be confirmed with immunodiffusion (ID) or the complement fixation (CF) test. When the ID or CF tests fail to corroborate the EIA results, the diagnosis is less firmly established.

INTERPRETIVE INFORMATION: Coccidioides Antibody IgG ELISA, CSF

0.2 IV or less:

Negative - No significant level of Coccidioides IgG antibody detected.

0.3 IV or greater:

Positive - Presence of IgG antibody to Coccidioides detected, suggestive of current or past infection.

IgG antibodies usually appear by the third week of infection and may persist for years. Both tube precipitin (TP) and CF antigens are represented in the ELISA tests.
