Clinical Interpretation: The pTau217 concentration was <0.07 U/mL. A test result reported as negative is consistent with absence of amyloid deposition in brain as detected by amyloid PET scan. A negative result reduces the likelihood that a patient's cognitive impairment is due to Alzheimer's Disease.

INTERPRETIVE INFORMATION: pTau 217 The Phospho-Tau 217, Plasma test is intended for use in patients aged 60 years and older who present with cognitive impairment and who are being evaluated for Alzheimer's disease and other causes of cognitive decline.

It is not intended to be used as a screening test or stand-alone diagnostic test and is not intended for therapeutic monitoring.
