Anti-MCV antibody concentrations of greater than or equal to 20 U/mL is used as a positivity cutoff according to the assay's package insert and an internal verification study. Positive results should be interpreted in the context of patient's clinical presentation, laboratory and/or radiologic findings, and current disease guidelines.

Anti-MCV can be found in patients negative for anti-CCP antibodies. Anti-MCV can be a useful marker for early RA diagnosis, and positivity has been associated with disease activity and poor radiographic prognosis.
