INTERPRETIVE INFORMATION: Vit B3 (Niacin and Metabolites), S/P Niacin (nicotinic acid, NIC) and its metabolites, nicotinamide (NAM) and nicotinuric acid (NUA) are measured in this assay. Measurable concentrations of NIC and NUA typically are not found in fasting specimens and may indicate therapeutic use of niacin. Vitamin B3 concentrations are reported in nmol/L. To convert to nanograms per milliliter (ng/mL), multiply the reported concentration for nicotinamide by 0.122, nicotinic acid by 0.123, and nicotinuric acid by 0.180. This test was developed and its performance characteristics determined by ARUP Laboratories. It has not been cleared or approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. This test was performed in a CLIA-certified laboratory and is intended for clinical purposes.
