Smith (ENA) Antibody, IgG

**Specimen Requirements:** 

Patient Preparation:

Collect: Serum separator tube.

Specimen Preparation: Separate serum from cells ASAP or within 2 hours of collection.

Transfer 1 mL serum to an ARUP Standard Transport Tube.

Effective Date: February 21, 2023

(Min: 0.2 mL)

Transport Temperature: Refrigerated.

Unacceptable Conditions: Plasma or other body fluids. Contaminated, hemolyzed, or

severely lipemic specimens.

Remarks:

Stability: After separation from cells: Ambient: 48 hours; Refrigerated: 2

weeks; Frozen: 1 year (avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles)

Methodology: Semi-Quantitative Multiplex Bead Assay

Performed: Sun-Sat

Reported: 1-<u>3</u>2 days

New York DOH Approval Status: This test is New York DOH approved.

Interpretive Data:

Smith antibody is highly specific (greater than 90 percent) for systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE) but only occurs in 30-35 percent of SLE cases. The presence of antibodies to Smith has variable associations with SLE clinical manifestations.

Reference Interval:

29 AU/mL or less Negative
30-40 AU/mL Equivocal
41 AU/mL or positive greater
