		13.4 AU/mL or less: Negative - No significant level of detectable measles (rubeola) IgG antibody.
		13.5-16.4 AU/mL: Equivocal - Repeat testing in 10-14 days may be helpful.
		16.5 AU/mL or greater: Positive - IgG antibody to measles (rubeola) detected, which may indicate a current or past
		exposure/immunization to measles (rubeola).
0099597	Measles (Rubeola)	0.79 AU or less: Negative - No significant level of IgM antibodies to measles (rubeola) virus detected.
	Antibody, IgM	0.80-1.20 AU: Equivocal - Repeat testing in 10-14 days may be helpful.
		1.21 AU or greater: Positive - IgM antibodies to measles (rubeola) virus detected. Suggestive of current or recent infection
		or immunization. However, low levels of IgM antibodies may occasionally persist for more than 12 months post-infection
		or immunization.
