### Ketamine and Metabolite Quantitative, Serum or Plasma

#### Specimen Requirements:

##### Patient Preparation:

Collect: Plain red or lavender (EDTA).

Specimen Preparation: Separate from cells ASAP or within 2 hours of collection. Transfer 1 mL serum or plasma to an ARUP standard transport tube. (Min: 0.3 mL)  
Test is not performed at ARUP; separate specimens must be submitted when multiple tests are ordered.

Transport Temperature: ~~Frozen.~~ ~~Refrigerated.~~ Also acceptable: Room temperature or ~~refrigerated~~ ~~frozen~~.

Unacceptable Conditions: ~~Polymer gel separation tube (SST or PST).~~ ~~Separator tubes.~~
