2003222 Antiphospholipid Syndrome Reflexive Panel

PHOS SYN

Specimen Required: Collect: Light Blue (Sodium Citrate) AND Serum Separator Tube (SST). Refer to Specimen Handling at aruplab.com for hemostasis/thrombosis specimen handling guidelines.

Specimen Preparation: Transport 2 mL platelet poor plasma in an ARUP Standard Transport Tube. (Min: 2 mL)

AND Transport 1 mL serum in an ARUP Standard Transport Tube. (Min: 0.6 mL)

Storage/Transport Temperature: Plasma: CRITICAL FROZEN. Separate specimens must be submitted when multiple tests are

ordered.

Serum: Frozen.

<u>Unacceptable Conditions:</u> For Lupus Anticoagulant Reflexive Panel (Plasma): Serum. EDTA plasma, clotted or hemolyzed specimens.

For cardiolipin and beta-2 glycoprotein antibodies (Serum): Plasma and other body fluids, heat-inactivated, hemolyzed, lipemic, or contaminated specimens

Stability (collection to initiation of testing): Plasma: Ambient: 4 hours; Refrigerated: Unacceptable; Frozen at -20°C or below: 3

months; Frozen at -70°C or below: 18 months

Serum: Ambient: 48 hours; Refrigerated: 2 weeks; Frozen: 1 year (avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles)
