Specimen Requirements:

Patient Preparation:

Collect: Serum separator tube (SST). Also acceptable: Lavender (EDTA)

or green (sodium or lithium heparin).

Specimen Preparation: Transfer 0.4 mL serum or plasma to an ARUP standard

transport tube. (Min: 0.25 mL) Test is not performed at ARUP; separate specimens must be submitted when multiple tests are

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ordered.

Transport Temperature: <u>Frozen Refrigerated</u>. Also acceptable: <u>Refrigerated Frozen</u>.

Unacceptable Conditions: Ambient specimens.

Remarks:

Stability: Ambient: 24 hours; Refrigerated: 1 week; Frozen: 1 month

Methodology: Semi-Quantitative ImmunoCAP Fluorescent Enzyme

Immunoassay

Performed: Varies

Reported: 4-12 days

Note: Method Description: The method uses solid-phase

immunoassays against 112 antigenic epitopes and measures IgE antibody concentrations in patient serum or plasma. The binding of a specific IgE to an immobilized allergen component is detected by the addition of a secondary fluorescence-labeled anti-human IgE antibody. Results are reported in ISAC

Standardized Units (ISU).
