## 2006247 Parainfluenza 1-4 by PCR

## PARAFLUPCR

Specimen Required: Collect: Bronchoalveolar lavage (BAL), nasal wash, nasopharyngeal swab or sputum.

Specimen Preparation: Fluid: Transfer 2 mL respiratory specimen to a sterile container. (Min: 0.5 mL) Also acceptable: Transfer to viral transport media (ARUP supply #12884). Available online through eSupply using ARUP Connect<sup>™</sup> or contact ARUP Client Services at (800) 522-2787. Swabs: Place in viral transport media.

Storage/Transport Temperature: Frozen.

Remarks: Specimen source required.

Stability (collection to initiation of testing): Ambient: Unacceptable; Refrigerated: 4 days; Frozen: 1 month
