Specimen Requirements:

Patient Preparation:

Collect: Serum separator tube. Also acceptable: Red (clot activator), lavender (EDTA), pink (K2EDTA).

Specimen Preparation: Separate from cells ASAP or within 2 hours of collection. Transfer 0.5 mL serum to an ARUP [standard transport tube](#). [Standard Transport Tube](#). (Min: 0.3 mL)

Transport Temperature: Refrigerated.

Unacceptable Conditions: Specimens containing particulate material.

Remarks:

Stability: After separation from cells: Ambient: [48 hours](#)~~Unacceptable~~; Refrigerated: [14 days](#)~~2 weeks~~; Frozen: [30 days](#)~~Indefinitely~~ (avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles)

Methodology: Qualitative Enzyme-Linked Immunosorbent Assay (ELISA)
