Patient Preparation:

Collect: Plain red or serum Serum separator tube (SST).

Specimen Preparation: Separate <u>serum from cells ASAP or within 2 hours of collection.</u>

Transfer 0.5 mL serum or plasma to an ARUP standard transport tube. Standard Transport Tube. (Min: 0.252 mL).
