Specimen Requirements:	
Patient Preparation:	Pain Discontinue pain medication, and any medications that affect hypertension or intestinal motility should be discontinued, if possible, for at least 48 hours prior to collection.
Collect:	Z plasma preservative tube (ARUP supply #40874) available online through eSupply using ARUP Connect(TM) or contact ARUP Client Services at 800-522-2787.
Specimen Preparation:	Separate from cells <u>ASAP or</u> within 10 minutes <u>of collection</u> . Transfer 4 mL plasma to an ARUP standard transport tube and freeze immediately. (Min: 1 mL) Test is not performed at ARUP; separate specimens must be submitted when multiple tests are ordered.
Transport Temperature:	CRITICAL FROZEN.
Unacceptable Conditions:	Thawed specimens.
