Prostaglandin D2 (PG D2), <u>Random</u> Urine 3000240, PROST D2U	
Specimen Requirements:	
Patient Preparation:	AspirinDiscontinue aspirin, indomethacin, orand anti- inflammatory medications should be discontinued , if possible, at least <u>for</u> 48 hours prior to collection.
Collect:	Urine
Specimen Preparation:	Transfer 10 mL urine to ARUP standard transport tubes and freeze immediately. (Min: 5 mL) Test is not performed at ARUP; separate specimens must be submitted when multiple tests are ordered.
Transport Temperature:	CRITICAL FROZEN.
