Methodology: Qualitative Immunoblot

Performed: Mon, Thu, Sat **Reported:** 1-4 days

Specimen Required: Collect: CSF

Specimen Preparation: Transfer 1 mL CSF to an ARUP Standard Transport Tube. (Min: 0.60 mL)

Storage/Transport Temperature: Refrigerated.

<u>Unacceptable Conditions:</u> Contaminated, heat-inactivated, hemolyzed, or lipemic specimens.

Stability (collection to initiation of testing): Ambient: 48 hours; Refrigerated: 2 weeks; Frozen: 1 month

Reference Interval: Negative

Interpretive Data:

SOX1 antibody is detected in patients with Lambert-Eaton myasthenic syndrome (LEMS) and in patients with paraneoplastic cerebellar degeneration (PCD), paraneoplastic and nonparaneoplastic neuropathy. SOX1 antibody is associated with small cell lung cancer. A negative test result does not rule out a diagnosis of LEMS or other cases of paraneoplastic neurological syndrome.
