Specimen Requirements:

Patient Preparation: Collect specimen 30 to 60 minutes after last dose.

Collect: Serum separator tube (SST). Also acceptable: Plain red.

Specimen Preparation: Separate from cells ASAP or within 2 hours of collection. Transfer 0.5 mL serum to an ARUP standard transport tube. (Min: 0.25 mL). Test is not performed at ARUP; separate specimens must be submitted when multiple tests are ordered.

Transport Temperature: Refrigerated. Also acceptable: Frozen.
