Specimen Requirements:

Patient Preparation:

Collect: Lavender (K2 or K3EDTA)

Specimen Preparation: Separate from cells ASAP. Transfer 3 mL plasma to an ARUP standard transport tube and freeze immediately. (Min: 1 mL)
Test is not performed at ARUP; separate specimens must be submitted when multiple tests are ordered.

Transport Temperature: CRITICAL FROZEN.
