Specimen Requirements:

Patient Preparation: Discontinue biotin supplements (vitamin B7 or B8, vitamin H, or coenzyme R) for 72 hours prior to collection.

Collect: Lavender (K2EDTA).

Specimen Preparation: Separate from cells and transfer 1 mL plasma to an ARUP standard transport tube. (Min: 0.7 mL)
Test is not performed at ARUP; separate specimens must be submitted when multiple tests are ordered.

Transport Temperature: Room temperature. Also acceptable: Refrigerated or frozen.

Stability: Ambient: 2 weeks; Refrigerated: 2 weeks; Frozen: 2 weeks

Methodology: Quantitative Electrochemiluminescent Immunoassay (ECLIA)

Note: Direct comparisons of absolute values can only be done on the same source fluid (serum or plasma).
